DRESSAGE IBOP 2014

The dressage IBOP consists of two parts. Part one will be ridden individually. Part two will be ridden with two or three horses in the arena at one time.

Part 1 - Individually

A – F – B – M – C Enter at working trot on the left rein

H – X – F Change rein

A Serpentine with three loops width of arena.

Between F and A Working walk K - X - M Change rein Between K and A Working trot

B Circle left 20m, one time around, at B track left in working canter

A Circle left 20m, one time around, at the circle lengthen the strides for a few strides

Between C and H Working trot

F – X – H Change rain in medium trot

B Circle right 20m, one time around allowing the horse to stretch the neck

F Walk K Trot

E Circle right 20m, one time around, at E track right in working canter

A Circle right 20m, one time around, at the circle lengthen the strides for a few strides

Between C and M Working trot

K –X – M Change rain in medium trot

Between K and A Working walk

A Down center line, between X and G halt and salute, exit arena in a free walk.

Part 2 - As a group

After the above test horses will come back in groups of up to three horses, age contemporaries together. The jury will be inside or next to the ring. The jury will give directions to the rider and evaluate the horses anew. This part will take about ten minutes. Horses will be asked for the following:

Walk: working walk and free walk on a long rein.

Trot: working trot, stretch the neck at the trot on a 20m circle.

Canter: working canter, medium canter.

Movements: tempo changes (three-year olds) + leg yields (four-year olds) + shoulder in (five-year olds).

The jury may deviate from the above apropos the ability and training of the horse.

Scoring: Walk (2x), trot (2x), canter (2x), suppleness, self carriage and balance, rideability/workability and talent for dressage. Maximum score is 100 points, passing score is 75 points.
