- B** Working gaits and halt, few strides medium trot, 20 m circles.
- L** Medium trot and canter, leg yield, rein back, 10 m circles.
- M1** Shoulder-in, collected trot and canter, extended gaits and counter canter, ½ turn on the haunches in walk.
- M2** Travers, turn on the haunches in walk, simple changes.
- Z1** Half pass trot, collected gaits.
- Z2** Half pass canter, flying changes.
- ZZ licht:** Four-tempi changes, ¼ canter pirouette.
- ZZ-zwaar :** Three-tempi changes.

When we give you the results of a horse it is presented as Z1+5, or M2\*. This means Z1 +5 winning points.

One winning point is given when scored between 60%-65%. A score between 65% and 70% gives 2 winning points, 70% or more gives 3 winning points.

The \* behind the level means that the horse has been in competitions at that level, but has not earned any winning points.

### Jumping

B	1.00 m (Jump-offs may go up to 10 cm [4"] higher)	3'3"
L	1.10 m (Jump-offs may go up to 10 cm [4"] higher)	3'7"
M	1.20 m (Jump-offs may go up to 10 cm [4"] higher)	3'11"
Z	1.30 m (Jump-offs may go up to 10 cm [4"] higher)	4'3"
ZZ	1.35 m (Jump-offs may go up to 10 cm [4"] higher)	4'5"
International C	1.35 m (Jump-offs may go up to 10 cm [4"] higher)	4'5"
International B	1.40 m (Jump-offs may go up to 10 cm [4"] higher)	4'7"
International A	1.50 m (Jump-offs may go up to 10 cm [4"] higher)	4'11"

In jumping one can earn winning points as well.

The rules are:

In the classes B-M: faultless course: 2 winning points, 0-4 faults: 1 winning point.

In the classes Z and ZZ: faultless course: 2 winning points, any amount of faults: no winning points
